TERMS OF APPLICATION:

Our youngest SuperSummer camper must be at least two and a half years of age and toilet trained. Our oldest SuperSummer camper should be comfortable with peers of six through nine years of age.

HOW TO ENROLL:

1. Submit separate registration information for each child, **prior to May 1, 2011**
2. Please read the **FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**.
3. Complete the **REGISTRATION FORM** and the **PERSONAL & EMERGENCY INFORMATION** in full. Financial calculations are made from the information provided. Confirmation of tuition total and due dates for each installment will follow for your review and approval.
4. A **DEPOSIT** of \$150 (**FEES**) is required to secure a reservation in **SuperSummer 2011**.
5. Families of new students will receive a student enrollment packet after registration has been confirmed.
6. The Entertainment Fee includes one goldenrod AMA camp tee shirt. Additional shirts may be purchased and must be prepaid. Shirts are available in goldenrod color only. \$15 for youth size / \$20 for adult size. Please provide separate payment for any additional camp shirt purchases. ***Tee Shirts Are Mandatory*** - *Shirts from previous years are acceptable if they remain in good condition and vivid in color. Children wear their camp shirts swimming and on all outings. Investing in a second shirt is optional, but well advised.*

AMA accepts all major credit cards. Checks should be made payable to American Montessori Academy.
